When buying a home do you know what you are letting yourself in for? It may have problems you will not be aware of, but which a qualified member of the Royal Institution of Chartered Surveyors (RICS) is trained to look for and report on.

Before you commit make sure you have the **RICS HomeBuyer Report** to help you:

- make an informed decision on whether to go ahead with buying the property;
- decide what is a reasonable price to pay for the property;
- take account of any repairs or replacements the property needs; and
- consider if you need any further advice before exchanging contracts.

Condition Rating	Definition
3	Defects which are serious and/or need to be repaired, replaced or investigated urgently.
2	Defects that need repairing or replacing but are not considered to be either serious or urgent. The property must be maintained in the normal way.
1	No repair is currently needed. The property must be maintained in the normal way.

The report is colour coded to make it easy to see if and where there are problems with the condition of the property.
